

Interior Architecture & Design Awards 2019

The Interior Architecture & Design Awards is the dedicated awards scheme at Architecture Expo devised to acknowledge and encourage the specialist disciplines covering both function and aesthetics in respect of interior design. Today's homes and workplaces need to support occupant wellbeing, and to even inspire. Architects and interior designers are responding to this challenge and these awards showcase all that is best in this regard.

All projects entered will be featured on the dedicated Interior Architecture & Design Awards stand at Architecture Expo so that visitors can view, and assess for themselves, the different design solutions presented, and their effectiveness. The winners will also be featured prominently in *Architecture Ireland*, and on the *Architecture Ireland* website.

Main sponsor is Walls Construction with Maria Kiernan chairing a eight-strong judging panel drawn from members of *Architecture Ireland's* Editorial Board, along with other noted industry experts.

Details of the Awards' categories, panel members, submission criteria and key points to focus on when making a submission are as follows.

Awards Categories

Projects up to €250,000

Projects between €250,000 and €1 million

Projects between €1 million and €5 million

Projects over €5 million

Submission requirements

Submissions must be made on A1 kappa-style boards — **presented horizontally** — and include images, sketches, drawings and a brief explanatory text. Up to four boards for mounting in sequence can be included. Boards must be anonymous and only show the name of the project.

NB: Font/typeface — Helvetica MUST be used throughout

The name of the practice and project title must be submitted in a sealed envelope and delivered, along with the board(s), to Architecture Expo, 9 Sandyford Office Park, Sandyford, Dublin 18, **no later than 12 noon on Friday, 20 September 2019.**

Submission criteria guidance

To assist with the adjudication process entrants are asked to briefly address the key criteria below when detailing the project description.

- (1) Core ideas underlying design principles;
- (2) Functionality — response to client/user needs;
- (3) Sustainability — approach in materials and design;
- (4) Relationship to context — how it engages/responds to new or pre-existing situation;
- (5) Additional benefits — added benefits in design response beyond that requested in the brief.
- (6) Health and wellbeing — design approach to a healthy interior
